

BYE-LAWS 5
SWIMMING POOL

In exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 16(b) of the Constitution, the Council makes the following Bye-Laws relative to the Swimming Pool and the surrounding areas:-

1. Members as defined in Bye-Law 2(a) below or any authorised or unauthorised person entering or using the Swimming Pool area as defined in Bye-Law 2(b), 3(c) below, do so entirely at his/her own risk and without liability of any kind on the part of the Society.

2. In these Bye-Laws unless the context otherwise indicates:-
 - (a) "Members" shall include Fellows who are not posted as defaulters, as defined in Rule 5(b)(i),(ii),(iii) of the Constitution, their spouse/children, guests, temporary Members and provisional Members.

 - (b) The swimming pool area shall include the Swimming Pool, Paddling Pool, Patio/Walkway surrounding it, Poolside Bar and Changing Rooms.

3.
 - (a) The swimming pool is open for Members between 10.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. on weekdays and between 9.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, except that Bye-Laws 10 and 11 apply at all times.

 - (b) Any alteration to these hours may only be authorised by the Council and/or the Manager.

 - (c) A nominal fee for the privilege of guests utilising the swimming pool will be set by the Council. Members are responsible at all times for the behaviour of their guests.

4. No person suffering from a transmittable disease is permitted in the swimming pool or paddling pool.

5. Pool users must shower prior to entering either pool.

6. No Member shall indulge in any form of dangerous games or other games which interferes with or disturbs Members in the swimming pool area.

7. No unauthorised person shall interfere with the valves, fittings, equipment or machinery of any kind in the area of the swimming pool, and shall not enter into the swimming pool water treatment room.

8.
 - (a) Normal swimming aids only may be used in the swimming pool.

- (b) No balls, coins, toys or other miscellaneous articles are to be thrown around or into the swimming pool. However, with the exception of coins, children are permitted to take toys and other playthings into the paddling pool.
 - (c) Adult members are responsible for making sure this rule is enforced.
9. Persons in swimming attire are not permitted outside the swimming pool area.
 10. Children under the age of 12 years are not permitted in either pool unless continuously supervised by an adult Member.
 11. Children under the age of 16 years are not permitted to remain in the swimming pool area after 7.00 p.m.
 12. Children under the age of 3 are not permitted in the swimming pool without supervision.
 13. No smoking, refreshments or food is permitted in either pool.
 14. The paddling pool is restricted to minors of 5 years and below.
 15. Proper swimming attire must be worn in the swimming pool.
 16. The Society accepts no responsibility whatsoever for any articles left or lost within the swimming pool area.
 17. A Member must produce a valid Membership card upon request by any authorised staff of the Society. Members must sign the attendance book before using the swimming pool.
 18. The Swimming Instructors may, notwithstanding the provisions of Bye-Laws 2(a) hereof, be permitted the use of the swimming pool for the purpose of conducting swimming lessons during periods agreed by the Council.
 19. Upon any complaint regarding the conduct of any member, a member of the Council or the Manager may temporarily prohibit the Member from the use of the swimming pool pending the decision of the Council.
